TENT WEIGHTS: Use of water weights must be phased out by 30 May 2021.

PLEASE NOTE: MARQUEE WATER WEIGHT PHASE OUT COMMENCES 2 MAY

Following up from Market Matters 15 March 2020 Issue 664 - RA&HS Policy - <u>WATER</u> WEIGHTS ARE NO LONGER A SUITABLE OPTION TO WEIGH DOWN MARQUEES.

Ben Baker, RAHS' WH&S Manager and SafeWork SA have made a couple of suggestions that may assist you with securing your marquee:

- Securely tethered to nearby fixed structures eg buildings, large trees
- · Securely tether to stationary vehicles.
- Any large weighted objects that cannot be moved without the use of a forklift..

As always, when using any temporary weights, it is necessary to use the manufacturer's guidelines for weighting your marquees especially during bad weather. Ben also suggested that stallholders <u>use ratchet straps</u> instead of ropes/occy/bungee straps as they prove to be more reliable and fray less.

The transition period has been extended to 30 May 2021. A follow up

safety audit of marquee weights at the market has been scheduled for Sunday 6 June.

Stallholders wishing to keep their existing 20 litre containers can empty them and refill them with sand. There is **FREE SAND** available in the Leader Street car park. Please make arrangements with Operations Manger to gain access to the site to fill your containers.



PARKING

Due to other large events on this Sunday at the same time as the farmers' market, parking will be at a premium. Please make sure that you and your staff do not park in the Rose Terrace car park areas.



NO CARD NO DISCOUNT

Please do not accept a picture of a membership card on a phone as evidence of membership. The market member must have their 2021 card or have obtained a special sticker from the Information Stand to get the discount.
