REMINDER: 2021 DATES TO NOTE:

- On the following Sundays, the market will operate out of the old Leader St location: 15, 22 & 29 August and 24 October.
- On the following Sundays, the market will operate as a pop-up market at The Orphanage Park, Goodwood Rd, Millswood: 5 & 12 September
- On 19 September we will be back at Stirling Angas Pavilion and Kingsway for a full market. Bump in of marquees, fridges, freezers and furniture will be on one day only, Saturday 18 September, although small items can be brought in early on Sunday 19 morning as long as set up is completed by 8.15am



We return to a new normal this Sunday with the following guidelines:

- It will be mandatory to wear masks inside the pavilion for stallholders and customers, unless a valid SA Health exemption is provided.
- Outdoor stallholders and customers will be asked to wear masks if they are comfortable doing so because of the difficulty in maintaining the required 1.5m distancing at all times while serving or paying. We ask for your cooperation in this regard.
- All seating will return to areas outside the pavilion but due to space restrictions will not be available inside the pavilion.
- Sampling of food and beverages will return with no contact as previously required and under/behind sneeze guards if pre-cut food samples
- Catering and coffee will return 😊
- Food can be prepared on site for consumption
- Please make sure you are hand sanitising between each transaction.

Facemasks:



- It is mandatory that everyone inside the pavilion wear masks, this includes both customers and stallholders.
- Inside stallholders are to keep their masks on at all times inside the pavilion unless eating or drinking, in which case they are required to step away from the counter and stop serving customers.
- Facemasks that cover both your mouth and nose must be worn. A simple scarf wrapped around your face is not deemed sufficient
- Outdoor stallholders and customers are asked to wear masks if they are comfortable doing so because of the difficulty in maintaining the required 1.5m distancing at all times while serving or paying. We would appreciate your cooperation in this regard.
- Masks will be available again at all gates for customers



Reminder: On Sunday, the 8th of August the ASFM will bump out of the Stirling Angus Pavilion and into the Leader St Pavilion.

- All **inside stallholders** are required to move their stalls immediately following the market and to set up their marquees and fridge/freezers in Leader St and move all other equipment to their Leader St site before leaving. We have a short time frame for turn around so please pitch in and help your neighbour if needs be.
- **Outside stallholders** that store equipment inside the pavilion will be required to move their equipment to Leader St Pavilion before leaving the market on that same day. Please plan your time to make sure you're available to do so.
- **The pavilion** must be completely vacated on this day.
