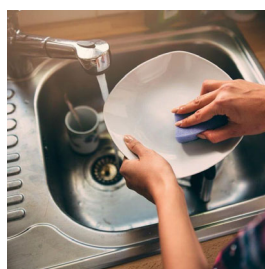
**Show Cancelled and we bump out again**

Sadly the Royal Adelaide Show has been cancelled for another year. This means we will be moving back to the Stirling Angas Pavilion/Kingsway location sooner than previously planned. This is now scheduled to happen immediately after the market on Sunday 22 and during the following week. We will once again have trailers, volunteers, staff and an additional fork lift giving us four to help us move. We would like as many inside stallholders as possible to bump out on that Sunday but there is an option to move during the following week from Tuesday - Friday. Please discuss this with Christine this Sunday if you are looking at taking the weekday option.



**The activity restrictions are now Level One Restrictions.**

- It remains mandatory to wear masks inside the pavilion for stallholders and customers. (Please make sure if you pull your mask down to drink or eat, you're well away (at least 1.5ms) from the serving counter and customers.)
- It is discretionary if you wish to wear a mask outside, however please still maintain your 1.5m social distancing
- Ask customers to step outside the pavilion to consume food or beverages.
- Thank you all for continuing to work with us to keep the market safe place to shop



**Mess Room for washing up**

- The mess room provided for stable hands during the show, is available to wash up stallholder utensils and dishes. You will find the mess room on the south/west corner of the beef stables as the Western Boulevard swings around from east/west to north/south. Access is via the door on the corner. ### Fruit Fly restrictions remain in place

- Wayville is still in a RED Fruit fly zone, and even though we are in the middle of winter, the restrictions put in place by PIRSA remain. This is especially important with warmer days starting to appear. This means produce at risk must be secured prior to entering the outbreak area and whilst in the outbreak area (refer to information sheet [here](#)). At the market, secure means packaging with no holes greater than 1.6mm or must be kept underneath mosquito netting with no holes greater than 1.6mm at all times. You can find a list of produce at risk [here](#). PIRSA will be making a visit to the market in coming weeks to check on compliance so please make sure the requirements are being followed.



### Health & Hygiene

#### Remember to remove your aprons when you go to the bathroom.

- We have received a number of complaints from customers, who have seen ASFM stallholders enter the toilets still wearing their aprons. It is a requirement of food safety standards to remove gloves and aprons before entering a toilet area.
