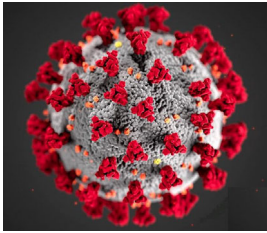

### IMPORTANT NOTES FOR THIS WEEK:

#### 2021 DATES TO NOTE:

- On the following Sundays the market will operate out of the old Leader St location: 15, 22 & 29 August and 24 October
- On the following Sundays, the market will operate as a pop-up market at The Orphanage Park, Goodwood Rd, Millswood: 5 & 12 September



**SA COVID RESTRICTIONS:** Due to the new enforced restrictions, there will be a few changes for Sunday 4 July.

- No sampling of beverages
- No buskers will be allowed on site or immediately external to the ASFM site
- All food and beverages must be take-away
- New maximum capacity limits are being recalculated by the RAHS and the new signs re this will be on the Stirling Angas Pavilion Doors
- Kids Club and Cooking Demos are cancelled
- All indoor stalls have Covid Check-in signs attached to their marquees, they will also be available for outdoor stalls to place up once set up
- Volunteers at the Eastern and Western gate will have masks available for attendees if they wish to take the offer up
- All tables and chairs will be removed from inside the pavilion, (there will be additional areas of seating made available outside)
- Membership kiosk will be non-operational
- Additional Covid Marshalls onsite



**WASTE MANAGEMENT:** This week we will be returning to a three bin system in time for Plastic Free July.

The three bins will be as follows:

- **Green** Lid Bin - Organics and certified compostables
- **Red** Lid Bin - General Waste
- **Yellow** Lid Bin - Scout 10c Recycling

**A reminder:** All stallholder waste must be taken off site by the stallholder and NOT placed in customer bins



**RESPONSIBLE PACKAGING POLICY:** Please remember that our Responsible Packaging Policy (February 2021) is still in place and ALL stallholders must use and offer EXCLUSIVELY certified compostable produce barrier bags, carry bags, coffee/drink cups (including sampling cups), cutlery (including tasting) and straws.

All pre-packaged products must where reasonably possible be in fully compostable packaging. This includes but is not limited to produce punnets, fruit and vegetable nets, food trays and containers, sauce packaging, polystyrene trays, bread bags and ties. Some exceptions are being made for fruit fly compliance only.

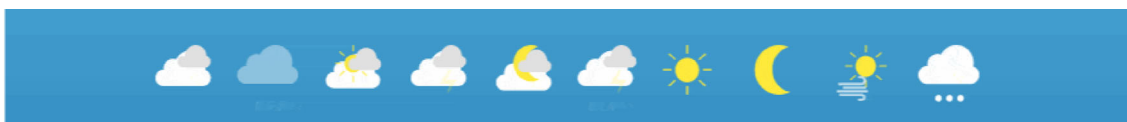
