Cooking Demonstrations

Store your Equipment

OUTSIDE stallholders - if you know you won't be attending the following Sunday's market then you'll need to store your equipment in the Dairy pavilion (opposite the CWA building on Western Blvd).

This can be done following your last market or you can pop back in on a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday for Friday and shift it then.



Controlled Sampling

Sampling is permitted and encouraged as it's a great way to talk up your product. Please observe the following:

- All drink receptacles must be single use only
- Samples must be single serve only, with no self-serve option
- The sample must be given to the customer avoiding touching their hands via a compostable serving plate/serviette/cup
- Social distancing must be strictly adhered too, with no lingering at the stalls
- Hand sanitiser must be available at each stall
- Each stall to have their own hand washing station
- A small bin must be provided in front of the stall for the customer to put their waste into it themselves



ANZAC SUNDAY TRADING: If you have not already done so, please confirm your attendance ASAP so we can update the stallholder list.



MARKET MEMBERSHIP AND CAR PARKING PRICE DROP: Please encourage your customers to join up. New membership is now only \$70, renewing membership is \$60 and the car parking pass is now only \$45 (members only). We stress that it's important that membership discount only be given to current paid up members as membership is an important source of income for the market.
