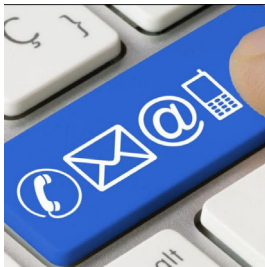

TRAFFIC Congestion

Sometimes trying to drive through the market to set up your stall is like trying to navigate your way through a traffic jam in New Delhi. When setting up your stall, remember there are still people with vans, trucks, cars, trailers etc that may need to get past easily to get to their stall site. Set up within the confines of your allocated site and don't 'push it out' a little. Keep your signs close to your stall until just before 8.30am when the market opens and then place them out. If you are using a forklift, remember that other vehicles entering the market have right of way. Unload and move your vehicles to the stallholders carpark as a matter of priority. Don't leave boxes and stock outside of your defined site area. Arrive ON TIME. Be considerate of other stallholders right to set up and trade without impediment. We are all in this together.



TEST & Tagging - NEXT WEEK

INSIDE STALLHOLDERS: Before you leave Sunday 13/3 please ensure that each plug can be accessed easily, such as moving your fridges or benches etc. The plug of your equipment, extension cords and power centres are what will be used to test your electrical items. If equipment **MUST** remain plugged in (e.g freezer or fridge) please ensure its plug is easily accessible and attach a note stating that it must remain plugged in.

OUTSIDE STALLHOLDERS/CATERERS: Before you leave Sunday 13/3, please ensure that your electrical equipment and plugs are LABELLED with your stall name and easily visible and accessible. **NOTE:** Plugs that cannot be accessed will not be tested. These will need to be done by you at your own expense before trading next.

You can choose to take care of your own Test & Tag if you prefer, however you will need to provide us with evidence that this has been undertaken – such as a copy of a report and test & tag sticker. If you arrange your own test and tagging it is at your own expense.
