TEST & TAG COMMENCES MONDAY 15 MARCH

Electrical Test & Tag is scheduled to be carried out from **Monday 15 March and finish on Wednesday 17 March** by an accredited tradesman. The cost of this is covered by the market as part of the market day power charges.

INSIDE STALLHOLDERS: Before you leave this Sunday (14 March) :-

- Please ensure that each plug can be accessed easily, moving your fridges or benches etc. if necessary.
- The plug of your equipment, extension cords and power centres are what will be used to test your electrical items.
- If equipment **MUST** remain plugged in (e.g freezer or fridge) please ensure its plug is easily accessible and attach a note stating that it must remain plugged in.
- Plugs that cannot be accessed will not be tested. These will need to be done by you at your own expense before trading next.

OUTSIDE STALLHOLDERS/CATERERS: Before you leave this Sunday (14 March) :-

- Please ensure that your electrical equipment and plugs are LABELLED with your stall name and easily visible and accessible.
- Plugs that cannot be accessed will not be tested. These will need to be done by you at your own expense before trading next.

You can choose to take care of your own Test & Tag if you prefer, however you will need to provide us with evidence that this has been undertaken – such as a copy of a report and test & tag sticker.

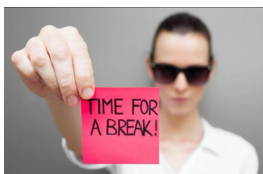
REMEMBER - 'Replace the Waste'

From March 1, 2021, single-use plastic straws, cutlery and stirrers will be prohibited from sale, supply and distribution in South Australia. This was passed by South Australian Parliament on September 9 2020; *Single-use and Other Plastic Products (Waste Avoidance) Act 2020*.

These single-use items can be replaced with reusable and compostable alternatives.

Stallholders and caterers who supply these items to customers should already have compostable alternatives available as outlined in the revised Adelaide Farmers Market APPENDIX C - RESPONSIBLE PACKAGING POLICY

Compliance in South Australia will be enforced by the Environment Protection Authority (EPA).
