Fruit Fly Detected - Black Forest

As a result of fruit fly larvae being detected in Black Forest, Adelaide Farmers' Market is now in a fruit fly outbreak area and conditions apply to persons/businesses selling fruit fly host produce.

These conditions are:

- Host produce must be secured prior to entering the outbreak area and whilst in the outbreak area (at the market)

- o Secure means packaging with no holes greater than 1.6mm
- Not grown within the outbreak area

A representative from PIRSA Biosecurity will be at the market this Sunday to check on compliance and to answer any questions you may have.



'Replace the Waste'

From March 1, 2021, single-use plastic straws, cutlery and stirrers will be prohibited from sale, supply and distribution in South Australia. This was passed by South Australian Parliament on September 9 2020; *Single-use and Other Plastic Products (Waste Avoidance) Act 2020*.

These single-use items can be replaced with reusable and compostable alternatives.

Stallholders and caterers who supply these items to customers should already have compostable alternatives available as outlined in the revised Adelaide Farmers Market APPENDIX C - RESPONSIBLE PACKAGING POLICY

Compliance in South Australia will be enforced by the Environment Protection Authority (EPA). Site tidiness: We would like to thank stallholders for ensuring their site is clean and left free from rubbish each Sunday.

Remember, before you leave the market, collect any rubbish from around your stall site and take it away with you. Sanitise all surfaces used for display. Sweep. Wash your table cloth (if applicable).

Promote Who You Are!

The start of the year is always a great time to do a little revamp your stall including signage. Please make sure your brand/trading name is clearly visible to customers so they know who you are.



ALL goods for sale should be presented neatly and have prices clearly marked for customer viewing using signage or a label if it is a packaged product.

This requirement is outlined in the Stallholder Rules & Responsibilities.

4.3. STALL SIGNAGE, LABELLING AND PACKAGING

4.3.1. Stallholders must have signs that clearly display their name, address, and business trading name, whilst trading at the Farmers' Market. Stalls must be able to be clearly identified by the consumer.
