Rose Tce Parking

Heads UP: Paid parking for ASFM patrons will resume on **Sunday 27th February**. Extra RAHS and Pinnacle staff will be on to assist with ensuring member's get in/out easily with their car park pass. SA Health will be terminating the lease of Jubilee Pavilion and shrinking back down to operating out of Duncan Gallery/Goyder/RCP1 so there will be less pressure on the Rose Tce carpark.



PRICE Cut

We are pleased to share that the ASFM Committee passed a proposal this week put forward to apply a temporary discount to stallholder fees of \$15 to commence 1 March 2022 until 30 June 2022. The proposal was put forward given the additional challenges the opening of borders and the Omicron variant has had on shopping numbers and buying patterns. Further cost consideration and fee structures will be reassessed at the time of budget development for the 2022/23 year.



FORKLIFT use

For those of you who use the forklift made available to the ASFM by the RAHS Sunday mornings, we remind you of the requirement to complete the log book **EVERYTIME** you use it. Please make sure you do so as this will be checked weekly by Jacqui and randomly checked by the RAHS team. Failure to do so is a direct breach of regulations regarding plant and machinery use at the RAHS and also the terms of the provision of the forklift to the Market. Please also read the <u>ADELAIDE SHOWGROUND SAFE USE OF FORKLIFT TRUCK</u>. Jacqui will have copies of these for you to sign on Sunday. Please also bring with you a copy of your current forklift licence for our records.



BIKE Racks

In more good news, the ASFM Committee have approved the purchase of custom made bike racks for our members use. These will be made so they can easily and without additional cost be moved as required to make way for other events such as The Show. (NB: Picture is not necessarily the bike rack we will have, its just a generic pic of a bike rack)



Just to keep you in the loop, we are now recycling all old lanyards and membership cards through a company called Terracycle. Members are dropping them off to the info stand and they are placed in a dedicated TERRACYCLE box which when full is sent off to Terracycle. The collected waste is mechanically and/or manually separated into metals, fibres, and plastics. Metals are melted so they may be recycled. The fibres (such as paper or wood based products) are recycled or composted. The plastics undergo extrusion and pelletisation to be moulded into new recycled plastic products. We have had great feedback already from many of our members.



COVID Update

Wearing of masks in the pavilion is **Mandatory** for all unless a valid health exemption is held. **Eating & drinking is NOT permitted** inside the pavilion to prevent masks being removed. We ask all stalls serving food or beverages to remind customers of the requirement to leave the pavilion before their purchases are consumed. Wearing of masks outside is highly recommended. **ALL** stallholders are required to have hand sanitiser available and within easy reach for customer use at all times.

Stallholders/staff exhibiting symptoms prior to market day should not attend the market until the symptoms dissipate and the affected person follows selfisolation or medical advice. Covid-19 symptoms include (but are not limited to) fever, cough, sore throat, fatigue and shortness of breath. Covid-19 most often begins with a temperature of 37.3C degrees or more and is contagious from the first sign of illness.
