There will be some stallholders who have never traded from Leader Street before so please be patient and helpful.

POWER

For those who are using power, please bring your LONGEST extension cords including your safety power station.

WEIGHTS

Ensure that you have adequate tent weights - one weight for each tent leg **HYGIENE**

Please ensure that you bring your portable handwashing facility, hand

sanitiser and gloves and tongs (if applicable).

PARKING

Farmers Market customers will be sharing parking spaces with the Caravan & Camping customers. All car park spaces in Leader Street carpark #2 and along the Western Crescent are strictly reserved for customer parking.

Once unloaded, <u>all non-essential vehicles and staff vehicles must be</u> <u>parked behind the Beef Cattle Pavilion</u> along the Western Boulevard (same as previously). The side gate will be closed at 8am - <u>See attached map</u>

AFTER TRADING 12.30pm

Your equipment can be stored back into the Beef Cattle Pavilion after the market.

BUMP IN TO STIRLING ANGUS

Bump in can commence on Wed 24**, Thur 25 or Fri 26 February - 9.30am -4pm

**There will not be a forklift available on Wednesday 24 however you can still bump in your marquee and other smaller items on this day if you wish.

'Replace the Waste'

From March 1, 2021, single-use plastic straws, cutlery and stirrers will be prohibited from sale, supply and distribution in South Australia. This was passed by South Australian Parliament on September 9 2020; *Single-use and Other Plastic Products (Waste Avoidance) Act 2020.*

These single-use items can be replaced with reusable and compostable alternatives.

Stallholders and caterers who supply these items to customers <u>should</u> <u>already have compostable alternatives available</u> as outlined in the revised Adelaide Farmers Market APPENDIX C - RESPONSIBLE PACKAGING POLICY

Compliance in South Australia will be enforced by the Environment Protection Authority (EPA). The EPA will use discretion when responding to any breaches of the legislation and can respond to non-compliance in various ways, To learn more click

Fruit Fly Procedure

Until further notice, Primary Industries and Regions of South Australia (PIRSA) asks that all stallholders keep their host produce covered with mosquito netting or packaged in bags/punnets (with no holes) whilst at the farmers' market.

PIRSA has been in contact and said that they will be conducting spot checks to follow up on compliance and answer any questions you may have.
