REMINDER: MARQUEE WATER WEIGHT PHASE OUT HAS COMMENCED

Following up from Market Matters 2 May 2021 Issue: 692 - RA&HS Policy - WATER WEIGHTS ARE NO LONGER A SUITABLE OPTION TO WEIGH DOWN MARQUEES.

The transition period ends on 30 May 2021. A follow-up safety audit of marquee weights at the market has been scheduled for Sunday 6 June. Stallholders using marquee weights, please ensure that they weigh no less than 25kg each.

Free Sand....

If you currently use recycled drums as marquee weights, the RA&HS has delivered a large bin filled with sand to the market to help get you started



with replacing the water in your weights with sand. Your drums must be filled to the top or weigh NO LESS than 25 kgs per drum*. Please bring your own shovel.

*Remember the weight guidelines are a guide only. For structure model and make specific loadings seek advice from the marquee manufacturer or your structural engineer
