Something to THINK about

With the ever changing Covid landscape, we are not sure what the rules and regulations will be in the future, especially in relation to vaccinations. It may be worth considering that at some stage it may become mandatory for us to open only to the fully vaccinated, which would include stallholders and staff. We are hoping this never happens and we believe it's unlikely, but in terms of Risk Management it does need to be something we are aware of. Womad has just announced that they will be 'no jab no entry' as have the Beer and BBQ event at the Showgrounds. Vaccination is a choice and we are not weighing into any discussion re its risks or benefits, and are not advising you either way, but given that becoming fully vaccinated takes time, it would be wise to take this into consideration. For your information the Wayville Covid clinic is open to 'walk ins' this Sunday, no appointment necessary.



The activity restrictions remain at LEVEL ONE

- It remains mandatory to wear masks inside the pavilion for stallholders and customers. (Please make sure if you pull your mask down to drink or eat, you're well away (at least 1.5ms) from the serving counter and customers.)
 - It is discretionary if you wish to wear a mask outside, however please still maintain your 1.5m social distancing
 - Ask customers to step outside the pavilion to consume food or beverages. There is no eating or drinking allowed inside the pavilion.
 - Thank you all for continuing to work with us to keep the market a safe place to shop

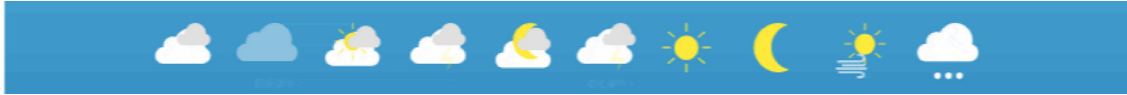
