REMINDER NOTICE: STALLHOLDERS MEETING - 1pm this Sunday 27 June, inside the Stirling Angus Pavilion, Demo Kitchen

MEMBERSHIP: It has been brought to our attention that some stallholders are giving membership discount to people that do NOT have their membership cards and are not current members. Even if they have been members for many years, please make sure they have their membership cards on display to gain their 10% discount. The income from membership sales is vitality important to supporting market operations. A printed receipt of membership renewal is not appropriate proof of membership.

ORPHANAGE POP-UP MARKET - Our pop-up markets are on the Sundays during the show, 5 & 12 September. We have an indication of great stallholder attendance and we are expecting this to be an excellent two weeks of trade. We will be confirming participation over the next few weeks with all stallholders.

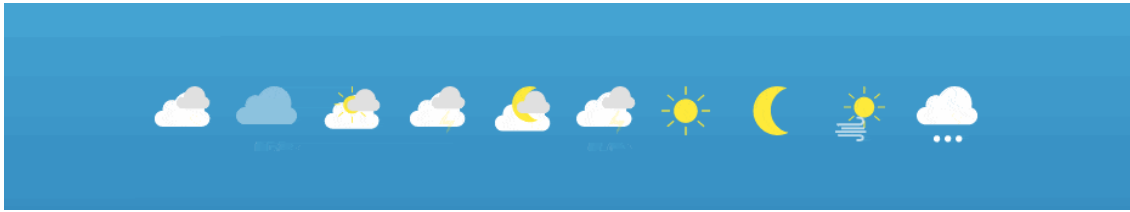
