[Trading HOURS](#)

Trading hours for the market are 8.30am - 12.30pm. This means that your stall must be set up prior to 8.30am and closed no earlier than 12.30pm. We have noticed a number of inside stallholders packing up and leaving well before this time recently and some outside stallholders packing up and dismantling their marquees. Doing this portrays us in a bad light for the other stallholders that are still trying to drive business right to the closing minute. We remind you that it's a condition of trade at the market and part of our Stallholders Rules and Responsibilities to remain set up for the duration-

3.3.3. Stallholders are required to have their Stall ready, with all products displayed for sale, by no later than 15 minutes prior to the Farmers' Market opening time. Stalls must be open, and properly staffed for the entire trading period of the Farmers' Market. Stallholders should note that various categories of members are allowed access into the Market to shop prior to the official public trading times.

3.3.4. Other than for reasons of safety, Stalls cannot be dismantled until the close of the Market unless prior approval has been given.



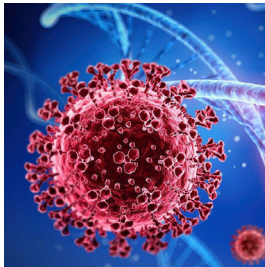
[REMINDER - Compostable Bags](#)

A reminder that all produce and carry bags provided by stallholders to customers **MUST** be Certified Commercial Compostable AS4736. We will be doing random checks on all stalls over the next few weeks and if bags are found that are not Certified Commercial Compostable AS4736, they will need to be removed at the time of inspection without further notice. The Responsible Packaging Policy requiring compostable bags has been in place since 17 February 2021. Produce bags from BioBag World, made in SA that are both Certified Commercial Compostable AS4736 and Certified Home Compostable to Australian Standards AS5810 are available from the ASFM info stand for \$16.50/roll and \$90/box of 6 rolls. Rolls carry 250 bags.



On SELLING

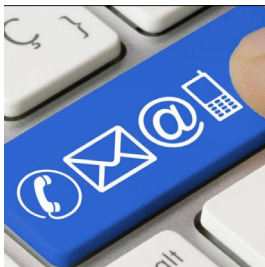
This week we were alerted to a stall selling produce/products that were not made/grown by them, which had been purchased from another outside company and were being commercially on-sold. This is a breach of our Stallholder Rules and Responsibilities - **2.4. RESELLING AND ONSELLING**: Stallholders may only sell their particular Allowable Products and NO reselling or carrying of products other than those of the Stallholder will be permitted. This also applies to selling product you make that hasn't been approved by the ASFM. Please make sure all applications are made and approved before selling a new product. Please also allow several weeks turnaround time to process any application. New product application forms can be found [here](#).



COVID Update

QR Check in is required on entry to the market. Wearing of masks in the pavilion is **Mandatory** for all unless a valid health exemption is held. **Eating & drinking is NOT permitted** inside the pavilion to prevent masks being removed. We ask all stalls serving food or beverages to remind customers of the requirement to leave the pavilion before their purchases are consumed. Wearing of masks outside is highly recommended. **ALL** stallholders are required to have hand sanitiser available and within easy reach for customer use at all times.

Stallholders/staff exhibiting symptoms prior to market day should not attend the market until the symptoms dissipate and the affected person follows selfisolation or medical advice. Covid-19 symptoms include (but are not limited to) fever, cough, sore throat, fatigue and shortness of breath. Covid-19 most often begins with a temperature of 37.3C degrees or more and is contagious from the first sign of illness.
