#### **IMPORTANT DIARY DATES:**

##### **BUMP OUT Sunday 14 Feb**

You will need to completely bump all equipment out of the Stirling Angus and Kingsway area after the market closes on Sunday 14 February.

Stallholders NOT attending the outside Leader St Market on the 21 Feb can store their equipment in the DAIRY FOOD HALL located on the Western Boulevard directly opposite the farmers' market or take everything home.

Stallholders who ARE confirmed as attending on the 21 Feb need to store their equipment in the BEEF CATTLE PAVILION - located at the Leader Street Entrance.

##### **TRADING Sunday 21 Feb OUTSIDE MARKET**

Trading will occur outside only in the Leader Street car park on the 21st February. Everything can be stored back into the Beef Cattle Pavilion after this market.

To ensure we provide sufficient parking for all customers, stallholders and staff must park their vehicles in [Leader Street #3 car park](#).

### **BUMP IN Wed 24, Thur 25, Fri 26 Feb**

Bump back into the Stirling Angas Pavilion can occur on wed 24, Thurs 25 or Fri 26 Feb.

Alternatively you can bump in on Sun 28 Feb before the market opens.

### **TRADING 28 Feb**

Trading will occur in the Stirling Angas & Kingsway area as usual on 28 Feb from 8.30am to 12.30pm.



### **This Sunday is the last Sunday for Red 2020 MEMBERSHIPS**

### **KEEPING SA FRUIT FLY FREE.**

Thank you to those stallholders who are continuing to take the appropriate steps to protect their fresh produce from potential infestation of fruit fly.

As per Primary Industries and Regions of South Australia (PIRSA) guidelines, fruit fly host produce **MUST** be covered at all times to protect from fruit fly. This includes when you are entering, selling and leaving the market. Ways you could do this include:

- Cardboard boxes sealed with tape (no holes)
- Plastic bags (tied or sealed with no holes greater than 1.6mm)
- Cling wrap trays.
- Mosquito netting with holes no greater than 1.6 mm

Penalties for non compliance may attract fines and pecuniary penalties.
