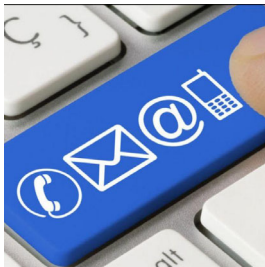

[Western Boulevard Fencing](#)

The Western Boulevard will continue to be closed to through traffic from Leader St to the Rose Tce carpark. The barrier fencing however is being moved further north to allow inside stallholders to enter via Leader St and then drive along the pavilion laneway to unload their goods and then remove their car and park in the Stallholder Carpark south of the market area. This laneway is used by numerous stallholders so please unload as quickly as you can.

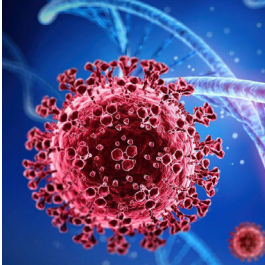
Demolition of the Thomas Edmonds Opera Studio and adjoining buildings will commence at any time now. Please **DO NOT** park your vehicles anywhere near or around the building or remove/change/adjust any of the barrier fencing surrounding the area.

[UMBRELLAS](#)

We have had some feedback re the umbrellas not being erected on various occasions, hence making some stallholders and customers unhappy. Please note the umbrellas will always be erected unless they pose a risk to market goers or a risk to their structure. This includes when thunderstorms or high winds are predicted as this goes against our risk



management protocols. They are also not erected if the forecast is for rain immediately followed by humid weather to prevent them developing mold build up. We thank you for your understanding.



[COVID Update](#)

Wearing of masks in the pavilion is **Mandatory** for all unless a valid health exemption is held. **Eating & drinking is NOT permitted** inside the pavilion to prevent masks being removed. We ask all stalls serving food or beverages to remind customers of the requirement to leave the pavilion before their purchases are consumed. Wearing of masks outside is highly recommended. **ALL** stallholders are required to have hand sanitiser available and within easy reach for customer use at all times.

Stallholders/staff exhibiting symptoms prior to market day should not attend the market until the symptoms dissipate and the affected person follows selfisolation or medical advice. Covid-19 symptoms include (but are not limited to) fever, cough, sore throat, fatigue and shortness of breath. Covid-19 most often begins with a temperature of 37.3C degrees or more and is contagious from the first sign of illness.
