IMPORTANT: Vehicle Access via Leader Street from this Sunday

Sundays: Market stallholders and their staff will be able to access the Leader Street boom gates until 8.15 am & again for departure from 1.00pm. Between these hours, the gate across Southern Boulevard between the Beef Cattle Pavilion and the toilets will be closed.

Western Boulevard will be closed at the northern end of the Market (unless the area south of the Stirling Angus is required for parking on high demand days).

The RA&HS will be staffing the Leader Street Gate from 8.00am until 1.00 pm for at least the first six Sundays to inform Farmers' Market shoppers of the change.

Weekdays: There will be no public vehicle access from Leader Street at all times, ONLY pedestrian access will be maintained. Farmers market stallholders, staff and couriers who required access to the Stirling Angus

Pavilion mid week, are exempt and can continue to enter via Leader Street boom gates.

This change is to address ongoing safety issues with pedestrians mixing with vehicles entering through Leader Street.

NOTE: The Rose Terrace car park remains strictly reserved for customers. Stallholders are not permitted to park in the Rose Terrace Car Park while the market is open for trade. Please park in the designated stallholder car parking area directly behind Tsimiklis' stall.



BUMP OUT/IN DATES:

BUMP OUT Sunday 14 Feb

You will need to completely bump all equipment out of the Stirling Angas and Kingsway area after the market closes on Sunday 14 February.

Stallholders NOT attending the outside Leader St Market on the 21 Feb can store their equipment in the ALPACA PAVILLION, caterers in the DAIRY FOOD HALL located on the Western Boulevard (directly opposite the farmers' market) or take everything home.

Stallholders who ARE confirmed as attending on the 21 Feb need to store their equipment in the BEEF CATTLE PAVILION located at the Leader Street Entrance.

TRADING Sunday 21 Feb OUTSIDE MARKET

Trading will occur outside only in the Leader Street car park on the 21st February. Everything can be stored back into the Beef Cattle Pavilion after this market.

To ensure we provide sufficient parking for all customers, stallholders and staff must park their vehicles in Leader Street #3 car park.

BUMP IN Wed 24, Thurs 25, Fri 26 Feb

Bump back into the Stirling Angas Pavilion can occur on Wed 24, Thurs 25 or Fri 26 Feb.

Alternatively you can bump in on Sun 28 Feb before the market opens.

TRADING 28 Feb

Trading will occur in the Stirling Angas & Kingsway area as usual on 28 Feb from 8.30am to 12.30pm.



PIRSA Inspection

Isabelle Oude-Egbernik of Primary Industries and Regions of South Australia (PIRSA) has confirmed her team will be returning to follow up on fruit fly compliance and to answer any questions you may have. Please don't risk getting a non-compliance order. Have your host produce covered up with mosquito netting or bring it pre packed in bags or punnets with no holes.

Is your marquee secure?

Having a marquee structure or display that can cause injury by being inadequately secured is a serious matter. All marquee weights for each leg must be put in place as soon as the marquee is erected and for the entirety of the market trading hours.

Please ensure that you include weights (and ropes) as part of your usual set up routine EVERY Sunday.

The ASFM reserves the right to action safety procedures if a stallholder's setup is deemed unsafe. This may include the pack down of a stallholder's site during market trading hours and a review of their License to Trade.
