#### MASKS are mandatory inside the pavilion

We know wearing a mask is the last thing you want to do but inside the pavilion it is mandatory unless you have a valid medical exemption. That means at all times not just when you are serving a customer. We are continually receiving emails from unhappy customers about stallholders not wearing masks so we would appreciate your cooperation in doing so. It is also highly recommended outside if you are serving customers or interacting with them within 1.5ms. The safer our customers feel, the less likely we are to lose them because of the current Covid situation. Thanks in advance.



#### **NO ENTRY**

Once the bell goes at 8.30am and the market is open to the public **NO VEHICLES** are allowed to enter or move around the market. If for any reason you are running late and wont make it in time, then the only option



is to park in the stallholders car park and then sack truck/trolley your marquee and/or goods into your site. If you don't have a sack truck or trolley please call Jacqui on 0419 105 228 on approach to the car park.



#### **COVID Update**

QR Check in is required on entry to the market. Wearing of masks in the pavilion is **Mandatory** for all unless a valid exemption is held. **Eating & drinking is NOT permitted** inside the pavilion to prevent masks being removed. We ask all stalls serving food or beverages to remind customers of the requirement to leave the pavilion before their purchases are consumed. Wearing of masks outside is highly recommended. **ALL** stallholders are required to have hand sanitiser available and within easy reach for customer use at all times.
