

STALLHOLDER RUBBISH

A reminder that the bins provided in the market are for customers use only, **NOT** stallholder rubbish. Stallholders are required to take their rubbish offsite with them. This includes empty egg cartons, plastic or



paper milk bottles, cardboard cartons, broken rice/slow cookers!!, green waste, pallet wrap and anything else that makes up stallholder rubbish. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.



WILD WEATHER

There's some blustery winds headed in from the west this Sunday, so this weekend is not the time to forget to weight your marquees properly. Please make sure **ALL** marquee legs are weighted and tied down with approved **NON WATER** weights or tied off to a car or solid structure. **DO NOT** tie your marquees to the perimeter fencing, as this is not considered a safe structure to do so. If your marquees aren't properly weighted and secured, they will be required to be taken down due to safety issues.



NO PARKING

AGAIN we remind all stallholders and their staff that stallholder carparking is in the Stallholders carpark, south of the market compound. **DO NOT** park in front of roller doors or entry doors to ANY of the adjacent buildings (even if there are no signs) otherwise you will be required to move your vehicle and this could be mid market. Access to all pavilions is required by showground staff 24/7. We would hate you to return to your car post market only to find it had been moved with a forklift or towed away!! Your free stallholder carpark pass is for the **Stallholder Carpark only**.



ON THE MOVE

Here are the dates you need to be aware of. **This time the August dates are correct :)**

Sunday 24 July - All Indoor Stalls must be dismantled and moved to the Leader St Beef Pavilion immediately following the market. All equipment stored in the Dairy Pavilion must also be moved. This must be completed on that Sunday.

Sunday 31st July - OUTDOOR MARKET ONLY Inside stallholders equipment will remain stored inside part of the Leader Pavilion. The Pavilion is not available for use that Sunday.

Wed - Sat 4th - 7th August - Indoor stall set up

Sunday 7th August - Full indoor and outdoor market Leader St

Sunday 14th August - Full indoor and outdoor market Leader St

Sunday 21th August - Full indoor and outdoor market Leader St. Immediately following the market all Indoor Stalls must be dismantled and removed from the Showgrounds. This must be completed on that Sunday.

Sunday 28th August - OUTDOOR MARKET ONLY

Sunday 4th September - THE ORPHANAGE OUTDOOR MARKET ONLY

Sunday 11th September - THE ORPHANAGE OUTDOOR MARKET ONLY

Sunday 18th September - Full indoor and outdoor market Stirling Angus and Kingsway (Set up dates to be advised)

Further information in relation to the bump outs and move will be advised closer to the bump out date.

Please Note: the layout of the inside Leader St market is difficult to achieve and tight. We are making sure that everyone inside at Stirling Angas is accommodated, however we will not be able to take on board any special requests for positioning of stalls. We appreciate your understanding.
