#### NO PARKING ROSE TCE 24 JULY

Due to the SPIN OFF event, there will be no parking available in the inner Rose Tce carpark on Sunday. This will affect stallholders who normally unload in that carpark. You will need to unload in the main market area and enter the pavilion via the southern doors. Cars/vans will need to be moved into the stallholder carpark south of the market area asap after unloading. Customers will be advised to enter via Leader St and park along the western circuit and around the arena or enter via Rose Tce and



# **EMERGENCY ACCESS ONLY**

Stallholders will **NOT** be able to park on the Northern side of the pavilion. This is an emergency access lane only this Sunday. Stallholders will need to unload whatever stock they need for the day from the southern side of the pavilion and then park in the stallholders carpark on the southern side of the market. Sadly the management team will not be able to supply any staff to watch stalls while more stock is accessed.



## **IMPORTANT - BUMP OUT INFORMATION**

Don't forget that we BUMP OUT of the Stirling Angas/Kingsway this Sunday, 24 July and head back to Leader St. Your cooperation and patience this Sunday will help to make the move a smooth and successful one. #### **TIE OFF YOUR WEIGHTS**

Please make sure **ALL** marquee weights are tied onto your marquee, **NOT** just sitting over the feet of the marquee. Marquee weights are ineffective in strong winds if they are not tied down. Failure to tie your weights onto your marquee may lead to serious injury of others and/or the requirement to dismantle your marquee to continue trading. Thanks for your cooperation.
