#### **THIS SUNDAY 11 SEPT**

We had a few issues last Sunday with stallholders driving in places they were not supposed to and consequently there was significant damage to the park turf which we are now having to restore at our cost. It's really important, especially given this weeks heavy rain, that you check in on arrival at the gate to the lawned area and wait for instructions from the ASFM team as to how to get to your site. This will save further damage and cost. We will be rejigging the layout to spread the wear and tear so you may not be in the same position as last week. Check the map **HERE**, but as always, the layout may change prior to arrival. As last week, you may not be able to configure your stall in exactly the same way you do at the Showground, but we ask for your cooperation in this matter as space is limited.



### STALLHOLDER/STAFF PARKING AT THIS SUNDAYS MARKET

This Sunday, 11 September, stallholders and staff must park quietly on the local streets around the park and **MUST NOT** park in the carpark adjacent to the market area. The carpark is strictly reserved for customers.

### STIRLING ANGAS BUMP IN, SAT 17 SEPTEMBER

It's almost time to head back to our home in and around the Stirling Angas Pavilion inside the Showground. Bump in is available **ONLY** on Saturday 17 September from 10am - 4pm. Forklifts will be available to help you unload your heavy equipment but please make sure you have your own team to assist in set up. The ASFM team will be busy setting up our own market equipment. The ASFM Cool Room will be available for deliveries from preapproved stallholders from 10am Friday 16 September.

### MARKET DAY 18 SEPTEMBER

The RAHS are working hard to make sure we have a complete inside and outside market on the first Sunday (18 September) after the Show. Those who have been with us for a while, will remember that this has always only been an outside market, so we are working with the RAHS to make it as easy for us and them, to make sure it happens. This means there will be some large marquees in outside areas which we will need work with/around. In most cases it simply means that customers will get more shade to shop under and in some cases, certain stallholders will not require a marquee as they will be under cover. Instead of seeing it as an imposition, it might be a bit exciting to do something differently. Those stallholders affected will be notified as soon as possible in the week prior to the market.

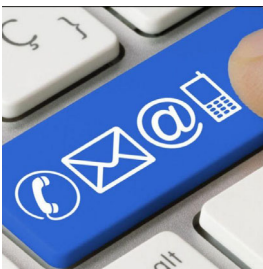
### PRODUCT APPROVAL

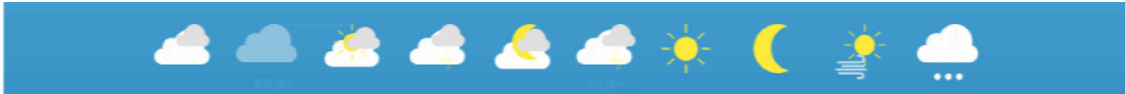
