STALL SPACE

Stallholders are required to keep their visual displays and products within their allocated stall space. If you pay for a 3m x 3m site, this is the area that you are able to occupy. Inside stalls each have an access area between every second stall. It is especially important that you **DO NOT** place anything within this area, preventing your neighbouring stall access to their site.



STALLHOLDER/STAFF PARKING AT THIS SUNDAYS MARKET

This Sunday, 25 September and onwards, stallholders are required to park in the stallholder carpark on the southern side of the market perimeter. The Rose Tce carpark is off limits to **ALL** stallholders and their staff as this is reserved for customers **ONLY**.

MEMBER DISCOUNT

It has come to our attention that a number of stallholders are **NOT** offering a full 10% off for members and are **NOT** displaying member prices as is required by the **Stallholder Rules**. The 10% discount applies on the full non members price. The non members price is not the members price



plus 10%. ie. If the non members price is \$5.50, the members price should be \$4.95 or lower. The 10% value decrease should be \$0.55.

2.2.10. On sighting an ASFM membership card, the Stallholder, or person operating the Stall, must provide to members of ASFM at least a 10% discount off the full-price of products. (Stallholders are required to ask any member to produce their current membership card before applying this discount). The Stallholder must clearly display both the full-price and the discounted members' price for all products sold at the Stall. Product prices should not be increased generally to accommodate member discounts which should be a genuine 10% reduction on normal prices. DISCOUNT NEEDS TO BE APPLIED AS AN ACTUAL DISCOUNT, RATHER THAN A FEW EXTRA PIECES OF STOCK ADDED TO THEIR BAG



WASHING UP FACILITIES NOW AVAILABLE

There are now washing up facilities in two locations with in the Stirling Angas Pavilion. Both on the Southern wall, one just west of Sushi by Jo and one behind Hahndorf Gourmet. When using them, please be considerate of those stalls around you. **DO NOT** wash fatty dishes in these sinks and pre wipe all food matter from containers before washing. Hot water needs to be available for all stallholders, so please don't hog the hot water and leave none for the next stallholder.
