The Adelaide Showground Farmers' Market (ASFM) was announced today as the 'Most Outstanding Farmers' Market' - Readers Choice' at the *delicious*. Harvey Norman Produce Awards 2022 as voted on by the community.

For the first time ever, the *delicious*. Harvey Norman Produce Awards gave readers the opportunity to weigh in and help name Australia's top farmers' market. Readers were invited in February to put their favourite forward for the chance to be crowned the Most Outstanding in Australia.

The Adelaide Showground Farmers' Market is held at the Adelaide Showground every Sunday from 8.30am to 12.30pm (except during the Royal Adelaide Show).

It's South Australia's largest farmers' market, with 3,500 visitors every Sunday enjoying our vibrant community atmosphere and supported by over 3,100 market members.

At the market the people selling the food are the people who grew it, baked it, caught it or made it. Stallholders' farms are inspected to ensure they meet rigorous market standards. From apples to zucchini, bread to beer everything is South Australian grown or produced.

Explore 100 stalls inside and out, bursting with fresh seasonal produce, direct from local farms weekly and find celebrity chefs like Masterchef's Poh at her JamFace stall, plus a great choice of hearty market breakfasts, fresh juices and great coffee.

Taste the difference when you buy fresh from the farm. Support the local families who grow the produce, milk the cows, make the cheese, catch the fish, bake the bread and make the pasta. A great relaxed morning out for all the family, often with live music, kids' entertainment and open every Sunday.
