## **HALLOWEEN EVE**

Halloween Eve is happening this Sunday and our shoppers will have the chance to VOTE for the best-decorated stand. ## **PRODUCT IN FRIDGES/FREEZERS**

A number of stallholders are leaving product in fridges/freezers in the pavilion during the week. We remind **ALL** stallholders, that doing so is at your **OWN** risk. The pavilion is part of the wider RAHS power grid over which we have no control and we can often be unaware that power has been interrupted. We suggest you install a temperature monitor that has remote reporting to your phone so you are fully aware of all temperature fluctuations so your food stays safe at all times. Please note: The Management team are unable to check your fridges/freezers.



### PRE MARKET TRADE

We have noticed a number of stalls are selling to people that are not stallholders/volunteers/official trade pass holders prior to the official opening when the bell rings at 8.30am. Apart from the fact that there is danger in that there are vehicles/forklifts moving around, stallholders have the right to be able to step away from their stalls and feel there is some sense of security with no public access allowed at this time, plus its against the rules. Please make sure your staff are aware of the requirement to **NOT** sell to the public prior to official opening.

### ONLINE SALES

Many stalls take online orders. **This is a reminder** that only goods approved for sale can be collected at the market. So if for example you sell 'truffles' online and you do not have approval to sell these at the market, then you are not allowed to have people collect them from you at the market. Online orders must also have the provision to apply a final 10% members discount to **MEMBERS ONLY**. And then this begs the question as to how are you going to know if they are **CURRENT** members online. Be very careful in your planning of online sales. Please don't hesitate to discuss options with our EO, Christine.

### TRADE PASSES

For those of you that are not aware, legitimate catering/restaurant **TRADE** are eligible for a **TRADE Pass**. This allows them official access to the market for purchasing between 7.30am and 8.30am. Without a trade pass, they are required to wait until public opening hours from 8.30am - 12.30pm. Trade passes are available through an application process. Information for trade is available at the Information Stand. Please note however, **TRADE** are prohibited from bringing their vehicles into the market at any time.
