If in an emergency, you need to depart the market, please contact ASFM management who will then arrange for you to be lead through the market by high viz personnel carrying safety signage. For those that did consider others safety, thank you.

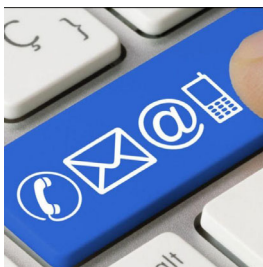
CHRISTMAS TRADING
