Sites will be close together, so we ask for you to cooperate with your neighbouring stallholders. Please follow the instructions of the ASFM team on arrival. Sites will be restricted to the site area you pay for, so if you are paying for a 3m x 3m site, then please make sure **ALL** your produce/products/marquee etc are within this space. It is therefore important to bring a number of long extension cords with you to make sure you can access power. Please note: we will **NOT** have any back up cords available this Sunday.



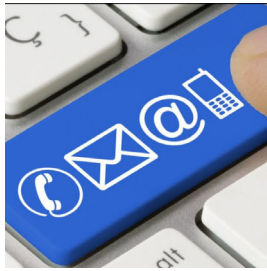
BUMP IN

Bump back into the Stirling Angus Pavilion will be on Friday 24 February from 10am to 5pm and on Saturday by arrangement only. All fridges and freezers will be returned by forklift to your stall site inside the pavilion prior to your set up on the Friday. If you normally store things on a pallet which gets forklifted in and out of a the pavilion each Sunday by the ASFM team, please pack your pallet the same way as usual post market this Sunday and this will also be moved prior to Sunday 25th into the Stirling Angus building ready for you. For those stallholders that have equipment stored in the Pig Pavilion for this Sunday, you will need to store the same equipment in the Pig Pavilion again after the market or take it home. You will only be able to move this at time of bump in on Friday 24 February.



SITE VISITS

2023 site visits will commence next week with the view to making sure you are making, growing or producing what you have been approved to sell and that the ingredients you stated you are using are in fact, the ingredients you use. These audits are part of the approval process to be a stallholder at the ASFM.
